POOLSIDE FACILITIES

Within the Tempus Spa sits our 15-metre indoor swimming pool, sauna, steam room and spa pool/jacuzzi. All residing guests at The Oxfordshire receive complimentary use of the swimming pool, sauna, steam room, spa pool and fitness studios. Robes and slippers are available from the Tempus Spa reception at a charge. The locker and changing rooms facilities are complimentary.

STUDIO AND GYM

The Oxfordshire has one studio with regular classes running throughout the week from Body Pump to Yoga. Please contact Tempus Spa Reception on 460 to check availability or book. The Gym includes a range of equipment from cross trainers to power plates. If you are unsure of how to use the equipment, please ask one of the instructors.

SPA & GYM ETIQUETTE

- Suitable swimwear must be worn at all times.
- Please ensure that you shower before entering the sauna, steam room or spa pool, especially after having a spa treatment.
- When entering the pool area you must not wear any outdoor shoes.
- Please note that due to health and safety regulations persons under the age of 16 are not allowed to use the sauna, steam room, spa pool or fitness studios.
- We would recommend that guests dress for comfort in a t-shirt or vest with stretch trousers or shorts. Trainers must be worn for classes and use of the gymnasium.
- While using the gym please ensure you clean the machines after use with towels provided.
- On the day of their departure, hotel guests can use the facilities until 12:00.

The Oxfordshire Dress Code applies to all Golfers on the course. Please note we do require visitors to be competent golfers and possess a current handicap certificate. Junior guests & visitors (under 18). PGA professionals will be given courtesy of the course provided they bring paying guests and notify the Pro Shop at the time of booking.

(All of these bookings must be made through the Pro Shop).

We strongly advise guests to reserve tee times prior to their arrival date; however to check last minute availability please contact the Pro Shop on 407 or 456.

Tee times cancelled less than 24 hours in advance will be charged at the full rate.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS & AMENITIES

BICESTER VILLAGE (Around 30 minutes drive)

Discover a relaxed shopping haven in beautiful Oxfordshire countryside, where spacious boutiques show case fabulously discounted labels from the leading fashion and lifestyle brands, normally only found in the world's most exclusive shopping streets.

BLENHEIM PALACE (Around 40 minutes drive)

Magnificent 18th century home of the Marlborough family and birthplace of Winston Churchill, set in splendid formal gardens.

THE ASHMOLEAN MUSEUM (Around 30 minutes drive)

The Ashmolean Museum in Oxford has become widely recognized as 'the most exciting new museum anywhere in Britain'.

WARWICK CASTLE (Around 1 hour drive)

One of Britain's greatest medieval castles, with historic themed attractions and events.

UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD BOTANIC GARDEN (Around 30 minutes drive)

The oldest botanic garden in the UK displays over 7,000 different species in a grade 1 listed garden with exotic glasshouses, water and rock gardens and beautiful borders.

COTSWOLD WILDLIFE PARK (Around 55 minutes' drive)

A great family attraction set in 160 acres of beautiful gardens and parkland surrounding a listed Victorian Manor House.

RYCOTE CHAPEL (Around 5 minutes' drive)

Once the private chapel of a noble household, this fifteenth century building has a unique interior including two roofed pews and a minstrel's gallery.

HIGH WYCOMBE (TOWN) (Around 30 minutes' drive)

Eden Shopping Centre (HP11 2DQ)

MILTON KEYNES (TOWN) (Around 45 minutes drive)

Central Milton Keynes Shopping Centre (MK9 3ES)

WOODSTOCK (TOWN) (Around 30 minutes' drive)

The Woodstock History Centre interprets the history of Woodstock, Vermont and the surrounding area. It houses a large collection of antique furniture, fine art, clothing, textiles, silver, ceramics, photographs and early American toys.

THAME (TOWN) (Around 4 miles)

A small town with a number of shops, supermarkets, pubs and restaurants.

OXFORD (CITY) (Around 12 miles)

A diverse city with many attractions including the Ashmolean Museum, Oxford Castle and Botanical gardens. Also has a large shopping centre and a variety of pubs, restaurants and night clubs.

BICESTER (TOWN) (Around 19 miles)

A small town mostly known for its shopping outlet Bicester Village.

BANKING FACILITIES

SAFETY INFORMATION

- To minimise risk following a shower or a bath when the floor is wet, please use the mats provided for your personal safety.
